**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

**ARTICLE 1. - NAME**

The name of the Corporation is PRESERVES AT PALM-AIRE CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION.

**ARTICLE 2. - PRINCIPAL OFFICE**




