THE UNDERSIONED, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of an Act of the Legislature of the State of Florida, passed as Chapter 607, Laws of Florida, effective January 1, 1976, do hereby subscribe to these A. Jeles of Incorporation.

ATTICLE II

To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of:

REAL ESTATE

To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, pledge, sell, assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in, deal in and with, goods, wares, merchandise real and personal property and services, of every class, kind and description; except that it is not to conduct a banking, safe deposit, trust, insurance, express, railroad, canni, telegraph, telephone or cometery company, a building and four association, fraternal benefit society, state fair or exposition.

The foregoing shall be construed as independent businesses, and the enumeration of any specific business shall not restrict any other business of the corporation.
