ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AMBASSADOR MEDICAL EQUIPMENT, INC.

The undersigned incorporator, being a person competent to contract, subscribes to these Articles of incorporation to form a Corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1 - Name

The name of this Corporation shall be:

Ambassador Medical Equipment, Inc.

ARTICLE II - Business and Activities

This Corporation may, and is authorized to, engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - Capital Stock

The authorized capital stock of this Corporation and the maximum number of shares of stock that this Corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any one time is 10,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share.

ARTICLE IV - Term of Existence

The effective date upon which this Corporation shall come into existence shall be May 28, 1996, and it shall exist perpetually thereafter unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE V - Initial Corporate Office: Initial Registered Office and Agent

- F. Any Director may be removed from office by the holders of a majority of the stock entitled to vote thereon at any annual or special meeting of the Shareholders of this Corporation, for any cause deemed sufficient by such Shareholders.
- G. In case one or more vacancies shall occur in the Board of Directors by reason of death, resignation or otherwise, the vacancies shall be filled by the Shareholders of this Corporation at their next annual meeting or at a special meeting called for the purpose of filling such vacancies; provided, however, any vacancy may be filled by the remaining Directors until the Shareholders have acted to fill the vacancy.

ARTICLE VIII - Indemnification

The Corporation shall indemnify each of its officers and directors, whether or not then in office, and his executor, administrator or heirs, against any and all actual expenses actually and necessarily incurred by him, including, but not limited to attorneys' fees, in connection with the defense of any litigation, administrative procedure or suit to which he may have been made a party because he is or was a director or an officer of the Corporation.
