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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AGRICOM, INC.

South 20 M B. M. The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is AGRICOM, INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE IL NATURE OF CORPORATE BUSINESS

The corporation shall engage in the business of Agricultural activity and any other activity or business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IIL CAPTIAL STOCK

The maximum number of share of stock this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is One Hundred Thousand (100,000) shares of common stock, each share having a par value of Ten Dollar (\$10.00).
