This letter serves as my request for forbearance and abatement of any penalties or other costs which might be associated with the enclosed Application for Reinstatement, for the reasons set forth herein. Any consideration that might be extended in the waiver of any such penalties will be greatly appreciated as I believe that are valid reasons which merit this consideration, forbearance and abatement.

Last year, I hired an accountant, one, Dan Del Vecchio to handle my taxes, bookkeeping and accounting matters. Mr. Del Vecchio was to prepare all federal and state returns required of my business.


The first problem is that the Application was originally mailed to Post Office Box 2043, which was an error on your part as that is an incorrect address. We did not receive the forms until sometime after its initial mailing. The second problem leading to the late filing of the Application is due to the fact that unfortunately Mr. Del Vecchio passed away suddenly and unexpectedly after being retained. Subsequent to the death of Mr. Del Vecchio I compounded the problems I already had, I found it necessary to terminate the second accountant as he frankly, in my opinion, lacked the necessary skills and expertise to handle my tax and had been doing an excellent job at clearing up all of the past tax and business problems, and has gotten me current, regarding all business matters.
