

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

F.N.G. MENSWEAR, INC.

WHEREAS

The undersigned, the majority of whom are citizens of the United States,
desiring to form a Corporation
for the purpose hereinafter stated
under the Law of the Florida Statutes
do hereby declare as follows:

I. NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be F.N.G. MENSWEAR, Inc.

II. BUSINESS AND POWERS

SECTION A:

The Corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the
united State and of the State of Florida.

SECTION B:

To enter into, make, perform, and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be
necessary or convenient for the business of this corporation, or business of a similar nature, with any
person, corporation, private, public or municipal, body politic under the Government of the United States or
any state, territory, or possession thereof or any foreign government so far as and to the event that the
same may be done and performed by corporations organized under the corporation law of this state.

SECTION C:

To carry on its operations and conduct business in any state, in the District of Columbia, in
any territory, dependency, or possession of the United States, and in any foreign country.

SECTION D:

To borrow or raise money without limit as to amount; to sell, create security interests in,
pledge and otherwise dispose of and realize upon book accounts and other choices in action; to make,

draw, accept, endorse, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, notes or other of the objects or purposes of this corporation, and to secure the principal thereof and the interest thereon by mortgage upon, or creation of security interests in, or pledge of or conveyance or assignment in trust of, the whole or any part of the property, real or personal, of this corporation, wherever situated and whether at the time owned or thereafter acquired; and, in such manner and upon such terms as the board of directors may from time to time determine, to sell, exchange, pledge, offer for discount, or otherwise dispose of any and all such bonds, debentures, notes or other obligations.

III. STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock which this Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time shall be One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock having a par value of \$1.00 per share. The capital stock may be paid for in property, labor or services at a just valuation, to be fixed by the incorporators or by the Directors at a meeting called for such purpose or at the organization meeting. Property, labor or services may be purchased or paid for with the capital stock at a just valuation of said property, to be fixed by the Directors of the Company. Stock in other corporations or going businesses may be purchased by the Corporation, in return for the issuance of its capital stock, and said purchases shall be on such basis and for such consideration as the issuance of so much of the capital stock as the Directors of the Company may decide.

IV. MINIMUM CAPITAL

The amount of capital with which this Corporation will begin business shall not be less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

V. TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have a perpetual existence commencing upon the filing of these Articles.

VI. PRINCIPAL OFFICE & MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office or place of business of the Corporation shall be located at 15 Northeast Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33304. The mailing address of the corporation where all correspondence shall be directed to is 15 Northeast Sixth Street, Fort Lauderdale, Florida 33304.

VII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Corporation shall be conducted by a Board of not less than one (1) and not more than three (3).

VIII. INITIAL DIRECTORS

The names and street addresses of the first Board of Directors who, subject to the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, shall hold office for the first year of the Corporation's existence or until their successors are elected and shall have qualified, are the following:

XI. AMENDMENT

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors, proposed by them to the stockholders and approved at a stockholders' meeting by at least a majority of the stock entitled to vote, unless all of the Directors and all of the stockholders sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these Articles of Incorporation be made.

XII. EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this corporation shall be the date as filed in the Secretary of State's Office in Tallahassee, Florida.

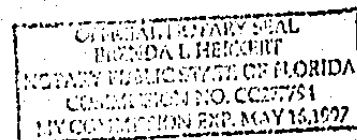
