MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE SHAREHOLDERS

A meeting of the shareholders of CKAP CORPORATION, was held at the office of the corporation at 10130 Bertram Lane, Fort Myers, Florida, on May 1, 2001, at 11:00 A.M. Further resolved, that the appropriate officers of the corporation are directed to cease the business operations of the corporation, except insofar as may be necessary for the winding up thereof; and to mail notice of intent to dissolve to all known creditors of and claimants against the corporation; and to take such further action as may be necessary or appropriate to carry out the intent of this resolution.

The Chairman then answered various questions from the floor after which there being no further business, the meeting, on motion duly made, seconded and carried, was adjourned.
