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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BILLINGS, WORKMAN GROUP, INC.

The undersigned, an individual, acts as incorporator for the purpose of organizing a corporation for profit pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Business Corporation Act, and adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The corporate name for the corporation (heroinafter the "corporation") is BILLINGS, WORKMAN GROUP, INC.

ARTICLE II EXISTENCE AND DURATION

The peri. . of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES AND POWERS
