ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PAMELA D. HORN, PROFESSIONAL ASSOCIATION

I the undersigned, hereby incorporate myself for the purpose of becoming a Professional Association for profit under the Florida Business Corporation Act and the Florida Professional Services Corporation Act pursuant to the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I. Name

The name of the Professional Association shall be Pamela D. Horn, Professional Association.

ARTICLE II. Principal Office
