# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, desiring to organize a Professional Service Corporation for the purpose hereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of Florida, hereby certifies as follows:

### Article I

### Name

The name of the corporation is Duke, Mullin & Galloway, P.A.

### Article II

### Duration

The corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

### Article III

### Purpose

The general nature of the business to be transacted by the corporation shall be and is to engage in the practice of law through a person or persons qualified to practice law in the State of Florida. The professional services involved in the corporation's practice of law may be rendered

only through its officers, agents and employees who are duly authorized and licensed to practice law in the State of Florida.

The Corporation shall not engage in any other business other than the practice of law. However, the Corporation may invest its funds in real estate, mortgages, stocks, bonds and other types of investments, and may own real and personal property necessary for rendering of the professional services authorized hereby.

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.

## Article XI

### **Bylaws**

The Bylaws may be adopted, altered, amended, or repealed by either the shareholders or the Board of Directors, but the Board of Directors may not amend or repeal any Bylaw adopted

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by shareholders if the shareholders specifically provide such Bylaw is not subject to amendment or repeal by the directors.
