The undersigned , acting as Incorporator of a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation :

- 1) **NAME.** The name of the corporation is **KOMPU-DATE , INC.**

- 3) **SHARES.** The number of shares the corporation is authorized to issue is **1,000 shares, \$1.00 per value.**

- 6) **PURPOSE .** The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any and all lawful business purpose allowed under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America .

11) DIRECTOR CONFLICT OF INTEREST.

A) No contract or other transaction between the corporation and one or more of its directors, or between the corporation and other corporation, firm, association or other entity, in which one or more of its directors are directors or officers, or are financially interested, shall be either void or voidable for this reason alone or by reason alone that such director or directors are present at the meeting of the board of directors or of a committee thereof which approves such contract or transaction, or that his or their votes are counted for such purpose :

1. if the fact of such common directorship, officership or financial interest is disclosed or known to the board or committee, and the board or committee approves such contract or transaction by vote sufficient for such purpose without counting the vote or votes of such interested director or directors; or
2. if such common directorship , officership or financial interest is disclosed or known to the shareholders entitled to vote thereon, and such contract or transaction is approved by vote of the shareholders; or
3. if the contract or transaction is fair and reasonable as to the corporation at the time it is approved by the board, a committee or the shareholders.

B) Common or interested directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the board of directors or of a committee which approves such contract or transaction.
