ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, is a natural person competent to contract, hereby form a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I NAME

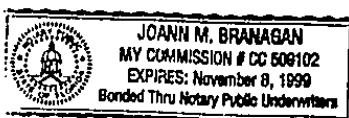
