

The undersigned incorporator hereby forms and establishes a corporation FOR PROFIT under and pursuant to the Florida Business Corporation Act (the "Act").

FIRST: The corporate name for the Corporation that satisfies the requirements of Section 607.0401 of the Act is: HeatWave Incorporated.

SECOND: The street address of the Corporation's initial principal office and its mailing address is 761 Sugarloaf Boulevard, Summerland Key, Florida 33042.

THIRD: The Corporation is authorized to issue One Million (1,000,000) shares of common stock with a par value of \$1.00 per share. Each of such shares, as and when issued, shall be fully paid and nonassessable. Such shares of common stock may be Class A Voting Common Stock or Class B Nonvoting Common Stock.
