ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ANNE-MARIE L. BOWEN, P.A.

The unpersigned, acting as incorporator of ANNE-MARIE L. BOWEN, P.A. under the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of incorporation.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The riame of the corporation is:

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the corporation is 225 E. Robinson Street, Suite 540, Orlando, Florida 32801

ARTICLE III. COMMENCEMENT OF EXISTENCE

The existence of the corporation will commence on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSES

This corporation shall be a Professional Service Corporation, and the general nature and purposes of business to be transacted, promoted, and carried on by the corporation are as follows:

ARTICLE V. AUTHORIZED SHARES

The maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any time is 1,000 shares of common stock having a par value of \$.01 per share. The consideration to be paid for each share shall be fixed by the board of directors and such consideration may consist of any tangible or intengible property or benefit to the corporation, including cash, promissory notes, services performed, promises to perform services evidenced by a written contract, or other securities of the corporation, with a value, in the judgment of the directors, equivalent to or greater than the full par value of the shares.
