The undersigned, all of whom are duly licensed to practice law under the laws of the state of Florida, adopt these articles to form a corporation under the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 621 Florida Statutes.

### ARTICLE I.

#### NAME

The name of this professional service corporation is Baker, Groover & Johnson, P.A.

#### ARTICLE II.

# PRINCIPAL OFFICE

# RESTRAINT ON ALIENATION OF SHARES
