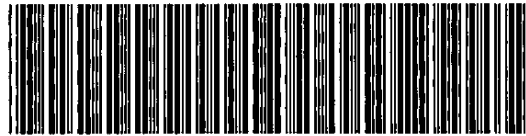

Pursuant to Section 607.1403, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Corporation submits the following Articles of Dissolution:


- A. The name of the Corporation is Olympic Title Insurance, Inc.
