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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF OF KIRKWOOD PETERSON ARCHITECTS, P.A. TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract and legally authorized to practice the profession of architecture in the State of Florida, hereby proceeds to form a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, and hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is KIRKWOOD PETERSON ARCHITECTS, P.A.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSE AND NATURE OF BUSINESS

The purpose of the Corporation and the nature of its business are as follows:

- 1. To engage in the practice of architecture as a professional service corporation and to provide services incident thereto.
- 2. To own property, enter into contracts and carry on any activity necessary or incidental to the accomplishment or furtherance of the purpose of this Corporation.
- 3. The services of this Corporation which consist of the practice of architecture shall be carried out only through officers, employees and agents who are licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida.
- 4. To do everything necessary, proper or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes herein set forth, and to do every other act incidental thereto which is not forbidden by the laws of the State of Florida or by the provisions of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock that the Corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is 1,000 shares having a par value of \$1.00 per share. Such shares shall be of a single class of common stock. None of the shares of the Corporation may be issued to anyone other than an individual who is

duly licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV. DURATION

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V. ADDRESS AND AGENT

The street address of the principal office of the Corporation is 1302 East Central Boulevard, Orlando, Florida 32801 and the name and address of its registered agent is Frank H. Killgore, Jr., 201 South Orange Avenue, Suite 900, Orlando, Florida 32801. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the office to any other address in the State of Florida and change the registered agent.

ARTICLE VI. DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors of at least one (1) Director. No person shall serve as a Director of the Corporation unless the person is duly licensed to practice architecture in the State of Florida. The Directors shall be elected by the shareholders of the Corporation. The name of the person who is to serve as the member of the initial Board of Directors is as follows:

VII. SUBSCRIBER

The name of the subscriber who is the incorporator of this Corporation and who is duly licensed in the State of Florida to practice architecture is as follows:

ARTICLE VIII. RESTRAINT OF ALIENATION

No shareholder may sell or transfer his shares in the Corporation except to another individual who is eligible to be a shareholder of the corporation under Florida law.

ARTICLE IX. DISQUALIFICATION

If any officer, shareholder, agent or employee of the Corporation who has been rendering professional service to the public for the Corporation becomes legally disqualified to render such professional services within Florida or accepts employment that places restrictions or limitations upon his or her continued rendering of such professional services, then the Corporation shall

require him or her to comply with the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act by severing all employment with and financial interests in the Corporation.

ARTICLE X. AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law.


