# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

### ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be LONGHORN CONSTRUCTION, INCORPORATED.

If the stockholders and the corporation fail or refuse within such period to make satisfactory arrangements for the purchase of such shares, the stockholder shall have the right to dispose of his shares as he may see fit.
