#### **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

### HECTOR CATÁ, CORPORATION

The undersigned acting as Incorporator of HECTOR CATA, CORPORATION under the Florida Business Corporations Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### **ARTICLE I - NAME**
