**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned Incorporator(s), for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME. The name of this corporation shall be:

FASTBOLT FLORIDA DEVELOPMENT CORP.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPAL OFFICE: The principal place of business or mailing address of this corporation shall be:

ARTICLE III. CAPITAL STOCK. The aggregate number of shares of stock this corporation is authorized outstanding at any one time is: One Thousand (1,000) Shares, all of one class, common stock, at One (\$1.00) Dollar par value.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE. This corporation is to exist perpetually.

ARTICLE V. PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS. Each shareholder of this corporation shall have the first right to purchase shares (and securities convertible into shares) of any class, kind, or series of stock in this corporation that may from time to time be issued, (whether or not presently authorized), including shares from the Treasury of this corporation, in the ratio that the number of shares he holds at the time of issue bears to the total number of shares outstanding exclusive of Treasury shares. ARTICLE VIII. INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS. This corporation shall have two (2) director(s) initially. The number of directors may be either increased or decreased from time to time by an amendment of the bylaws of the corporation in the manner provided by law but shall never be less than one (1).

ARTICLE XII. AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES. This corporation may amend its Articles of Incorporation at any time to add or change a provision that is required or permitted in the Articles of Incorporation or to delete a provision not required in the Articles of Incorporation. In any election of directors by the shareholders, each shareholder of record shall have the right to cumulate his shares and to give one (1) candidate as many votes as the number of directors to be elected multiplied by the number of shares equals, or to distribute them on the same principle among as many candidates as he sees fit, provided however, that notice shall be given by any shareholder to the President or a Vice President of the corporation not less than twenty-four (24) hours before the time fixed for the holding of the meeting for the election of directors that he intends to cumulate his votes at such election. This right to vote

cumulatively shall not be further restricted or qualified by any provision in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE XIV. INDEMNIFICATION. The corporation may be empowered to indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director in the manner set out and provided for pursuant to the provision of §607.0850, Florida Statutes.
