- A. A negative x-ray report should not delay biopsy if a dominant or clinically suspicious mass is present. 8-10 percent of cancers are not identified by x-ray.
- B. Mammography as a screening examination is not appropriate for use in women who have breast symptoms such as a lump or an abnormal discharge from the nipple. These women need to have a more comprehensive examination.
- C. Adenosis and dense breasts may obscure an underlying neoplasm.
- D. False positive reports average 6-10 percent.
