I, the undersigned, being desirous of forming a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida, declare:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be:

NEW PORT EXPORT & IMPORT INC.

ARTICLE II

AUTHORIZED SHARES

The maximum number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue and have outstanding at any time is 1000 shares of common stock, and which common stock shall have a par value of \$ 1 per share. All stock is to be issued fully paid and exempt from assessment.

ARTICLE III

TERM OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The date when corporate existence shall commence shall be upon the filing of these Articles with the Department of State. The corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLES VIII

INDEMNIFICATION

Every incorporator, director and every officer of the corporation shall be indemnified by the corporation against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fee reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding to which he may be a party, or in which he may become involved, by reason of his being of having been a director or officer of the corporation, or any settlement thereof, whether or not he is a director or officer at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the director or officer is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance in the performance of his duties; provided that in the event of settlement the indemnification herein shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves, by a two-thirds vote, such settlement and reimbursement as being for the best interests of the corporation.
