

We, the undersigned incorporators, hereby associate ourselves together and make, subscribe, acknowledge and file with the Secretary of State of Florida these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation for profit in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of this corporation shall be: HAIR WE GO AGAIN ORLANDO, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The corporation may engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of this state:

ARTICLE III - CALITAL STOCK

- (a) The total number of shares of capital stock authorized to be issued by the corporation shall be 500 shares having a par value of \$1.00 per share. Each of the said shares of stock shall entitle the holder thereof to (1) vote at any meeting of the stockholders. All or any part of said capital stock may be paid for in cash, in property or in labor or service at a fair valuation to be fixed by the Board of Directors at a meeting called for such purpose. All stock when issued shall be paid for and shall be non-assessable.
- (b) In the election of directors of this corporation there shall be no cumulative voting of the stock entitled to vote at such election.
- (c) No holder of stock of the corporation of any class shall have any preemptive or preferential right to subscribed to, purchase or receive any shares of any class of stock of the corporation, whether now or hereafter, authorized, or any notes, debentures, bonds, to purchase, shares of any class, may be issued and disposed of or sold by the Board of Directors on such terms and for such consideration, so far as may be permitted by law, and to such person or persons as the Board of Directors may determine.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL TO BEGIN BUBINESS

The amount of capital with which this corporation will begin business will be five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

ARTICLE V - TERMS OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE VI - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of this corporation shall be located at:

but the corporation shall have the power to relocate its principal office or to establish branch offices at other places within or without the State of Florida as may be determined and deemed expedient.

ARTICLE VII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS.

There shall be a Board of Directors for this corporation which shall consist of not less than one (1) and not more than fifteen (15) members, the number of the same to be fixed by the stock-holders or by the corporate by-laws. Each of the said directors shall be of full age and at least one of them shall be a citizen of the United States. A quorum for the transaction of business shall be a majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the directors subject to the by-laws of this corporation, meetings of the directors may be held within or without the Sate of Florida. Directors need not be stockholders. The stockholders of this corporation may remove any director from office at any time with or without cause.

ARTICLE VIII - FIRST BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The names and street addresses of the members of the first Board of Directors of this corporation, who, subject to these Articles of Incorporation, the by-laws of this corporation and the laws of the State of Florida, shall hold office, for the first year of the existence of this corporation, or until an election is held by the stockholders for the election of permanent directors, or until their successors have been duly elected and qualified, are:

ARTICLE X - COMMENCEMENT OF CORPORATE EXISTENCE

The date for commencement of this corporation's existence shall be the Fifteenth day of September, 1996.

ARTICLE XI - TRANSACTIONS WITH CORPORATION

No contract or other transaction between this corporation and any other corporation and no other contract or transaction of this corporation, shall in any way be affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors of this corporation are pecuniarily or otherwise interested in any other corporation, or are directors of officers of any other corporation. Any director individually, or any firm of which any director may be a member, may be a party to, or may be pecuniarily or otherwise interested in, any contract or transaction of this corporation, provided that the fact that (he) or such firm is so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors. Any director of this corporation who is also a director or officer of such other corporations or member of such firm, or who is so interested, may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of this corporation which shall authorize any such contract or transaction, with like force and effect as if (he) were not such officer of director of such other corporation or member of such firm, or not so interested.

ARTICLE XII - BY-LAWS

- (a) The power to adopt the by-laws of this corporation, to alter, amend or repeal the by-laws, or to adopt new by-laws, shall be vested in the Board of Directors of this corporation, provided, however, that any by-laws or amendments thereto as adopted by the Board of Directors may be altered, amended or repealed by vote of the stockholders entitled to vote thereon, or a new by-law in lieu thereof may be adopted by vote of the stockholders. No by-law which has been altered, amended, or adopted by such a vote of the stockholders may be altered, amended or repealed by the vote of the directors until two years shall have expired since such action by vote of such stockholders.
- (b) The by-laws of this corporation shall be for the government of the corporation and may contain any provisions for requirements for the management or conduct of the affairs and business.

ARTICLE XIII - AMENDMENTS

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, or change, or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by statue, and all rights conferred upon the stockholders herein are subject to this reservation.
