ARTICLE I. MAME

The name of this corporation shall be Jacksonville Professional Soccer, Inc.

ARTICLE II. COMMEMCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles Of Incorporation by the Florida Department of State. This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.
