THE UNDERSIGNED SUBSCRIBER to these articles of Incorporation a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

#### ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is:
GUYCO DEVELOPERS INC.

## ARTICLE II

#### NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is:

- a) To engage in every aspect and phase of the business of manufacturing, scanning, producing, selling and marketing computer graphics, separations and four color film processing, typesetting & printing.
- b) To manufacture, purchase, or otherwise acquire, and to own, mortgage, , sell, assign, transfer or otherwise dispose of, and to invest in, trade in and with, goods, wares, merchandise,
