ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THERESA M. SKAHILL, 95 SEP 27 All 11:01

The undersigned incorporator, who is licensed of otherwise ATE legally authorized to practice the profession of law in the state RIDA of Florida, associates herself with the intention of forming a professional corporation in accordance with the Florida Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act, and adopts the following articles of incorporation for the corporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT
