ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator(s) for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this corporation shall be:

INDIAN BLUFF ESTATES, INC.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III

The number of shares of stock that this corporation is authorized to have outstanding at any one time is ONE THOUSAND (1,000) shares with a par value of ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) per share.
