
We have received notice of administrative dissolution or revocation from your office. The notice states the Florida Department of State has administratively dissolved this corporation or revoked its authority to transact business in the state for failure to file its 1998 corporation annual report form as required by law. Accordingly, we are corresponding with you to explain the circumstances surrounding the 1998 corporation annual report and respectfully request abatement of the \$600 reinstatement fee.

Dr. Hugo Keim, president of Carenacia Tree Farm Inc., did not receive the pre-printed annual report normally sent to the corporation for updating and submission of the required annual fee. As Dr. Keim has limited knowledge of Florida administrative matters, he was unaware that the annual report was due May 1. Rule 12-13.007 of the Florida Administrative Code provides guidance to determine when grounds for reasonable cause exists for compromise of penalties (see attached). Although the reinstatement fee may not technically be a penalty, we do believe the facts and circumstances surrounding our issue merits some leniency as reasonable cause does exist.

Dr Keim has limited experience with Florida Administrative matters and has implemented procedures (tickler system) to preclude reoccurrence of this matter. Carenacia Tree Farm Inc.'s lengthy history of compliance with governmental agencies coupled with the facts and circumstances surrounding this issue which meet the reasonable cause criteria in the Florida Administrative Code are the basis for our request for abatement of the \$600 reinstatement fee. Accordingly, we have enclosed a check in the amount of \$150 for the annual report and corporate supplemental fees.
