

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**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
NEWKAT, INC.**

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is NEWKAT, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually, commencing at the time of filing these articles with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSES

This corporation is organized for the purposes of conducting any or all lawful business.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation is authorized to issue one thousand (1,000) shares at \$.01 par value, common stock, which shall be designated "Common Shares". Two hundred (200) shares shall be issued initially and eight hundred (800) shares shall be held outstanding.

ARTICLE V - VOTING RIGHTS

Except as otherwise provided by law, the entire voting power for the election of directors and for all other purposes shall be vested exclusively in the holders of the outstanding Common Shares.

ARTICLE VI - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may be done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

ARTICLE VII - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 172 E. Merritt Island Cswy., Merritt Island, Florida 32952, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is: Mary L. Rao.

ARTICLE VIII - INITIAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS

This corporation shall have two (2) directors initially. The number of directors may be either increased or diminished from time to time by the bylaws, but shall never be less than one. The names and addresses of the initial directors of this corporation are: Mary L. Rao of 277 Via De La Reina, Merritt Island, Florida 32953 and Sangnuane Bostrom of 310 Diana Blvd., Merritt Island, Florida 32953.

ARTICLE IX - INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address of the initial principal office is 172 E. Merritt Island Cswy., Merritt Island, Florida 32952, and is the same address as the initial registered agent of the corporation as contained in Article VII of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE X - INCORPORATORS

The names and addresses of the persons signing these Articles are: Mary L. Rao of 277 Via De La Reina, Merritt Island, Florida 32953 and Sangnuane Bostrom of 310 Diana Blvd., Merritt Island, Florida 32953.

ARTICLE XI - BYLAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the Shareholders.

ARTICLE XII - CALLING OF SPECIAL MEETINGS

Special meetings of shareholders may be called by the Board of Directors of this Corporation.

ARTICLE XIII - SHAREHOLDER QUORUM AND VOTING

Fifty-One percent (51%) of the shares entitled to vote, represented in person or by proxy, shall constitute a quorum at a meeting of shareholders. If a quorum is present, the affirmative vote of fifty-one percent (51%) of the shares represented at the meeting and entitled to vote on the subject matter shall be the act of the shareholders.

ARTICLE XIV - INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE XV - AMENDMENT

The corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment thereto, and any right conferred upon the shareholders is subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE XVI - RESTRICTIONS ON TRANSFER OF STOCK

Shares of capital stock of this corporation shall be issued initially to the following persons in the amount set forth opposite their name: Mary L. Rao - one hundred (100) shares and Sangnuane Bostrom - one hundred (100) shares.

Shares held by the initial stockholders listed above may not be resold or otherwise transferred to other persons unless such shares are first offered to the remaining shareholders or to this corporation.

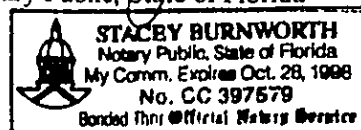
