WE, the undersigned, do submit these Articles for the purpose of becoming a Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, by and under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, liabilities, rights, privileges, and immunities of corporations.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be: PARA TRANSIT OF
BREVARD COUNTY, INC. Its business shall be carried out at
2225 White Sands Drive, Titusville, Brevard County, FL 32780, or
at such other points or places in the State of Florida, the
United States, or foreign countries as may, from time to time, be
authorized by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE II
