ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION



OF

GDM MANAGEMENT, INC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of formings a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article One - Name

The name of the corporation is GDM MANAGEMENT, INC.

Article Two - Nature of Business and Powers

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is to engage in any and all business permitted under the laws of the State of Florida.
