ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF REGENCY ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator under the provisions of Florida Statutes, Chapter 607, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this Corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II

Principal Office

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

Term of Existence

The duration of this Corporation is to be perpetual.

<u>Purposes</u>

Stock Clause

The aggregate number of shares of stock which this Corporation shall have authority to issue shall be 10,000 shares of common stock, each with a par value of \$.01.

Directors

This Corporation shall initially have one director. The number of directors may be increased or decreased by an appropriate amendment to the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall never be less than one. The name and mailing address of the initial Board of Directors is as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

Informal Shareholder Action

Any action of the Shareholders may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, shall be signed by the holders of outstanding stock having not less than the minimum number of votes that would be necessary to authorize or take such action at a meeting at which all shares entitled to vote thereon were present and voted. Notice of any such action so taken shall be given within ten (10) days of the date of such action to those Shareholders entitled to vote thereon who did not give their written consent.

ARTICLE IX

Stock Transfer Agreement

If all, or any, of the Shareholders or Subscribers to the stock of the Corporation shall enter into any agreement between themselves or the Corporation or third persons, abridging, limiting, restricting or changing the rights or interest of any one or more of the Shareholders or Subscribers to sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, hypothecate or transfer on the books of the Corporation, any and all of the stocks of the Corporation held

by them, and if a copy of the agreement is filed with the Corporation, all certificates of shares, subject to such agreement

or restriction, shall have a reference thereto endorsed thereon by an officer of the Corporation and such stock shall not thereafter be transferred on the books of the Corporation except in accordance with the terms and provisions of the agreement. If the agreement so provides, the certificates of stock shall be registered so that shares standing in the name of any person as pledgee, trustee or other fiduciary may be voted, in person or by proxy, and without proof of authority.

ARTICLE X

Fundamental Changes

The affirmative vote of holders of fifty one percent (51%) of the outstanding shares of all classes of stock entitled to vote shall be necessary for the following corporate action:

- (a) Amendment, alteration, change or repeal of any provision of the Articles of Incorporation;
 - (b) Reorganization, merger, or consolidation of the Corporation;
- © Sale, lease or exchange of the major portion of 3 Corporation;

(d) Dissolution of the Corporation.

ARTICLE XI

Inspection of Books

Each Shareholder shall have the unqualified right and privilege to examine all corporate books, records and correspondence. This privilege of examination is conditioned by the provision that the Shareholder agrees to indemnify the Corporation for losses suffered by improper disclosure of information obtained in the course of such inspection. The Shareholder may not delegate the right of inspection.

Long-Term Employment Contract

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF REGENCY ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 607.1006 of the Florida Rusiness Corporation Act, REGENCY ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., a Florida corporation (the "Corporation") adopts the following Articles of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation:

- 1. Name of Corporation. The name of the Corporation is REGENCY ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC.
- 2. <u>Amendments</u>. The Articles of Incorporation of said Corporation shall be amended by (a) revising Article V to read as follows:

ARTICLE V CAPITALIZATION

The aggregate number of shares of stock which this Corporation shall have authority to issue shall be 100,000 shares of common stock, each with a par value of \$0.01. All of the shares of stock of the Corporation shall have identical rights, except that 10,000 shares shall be voting stock and 90,000 shares shall be non-voting stock.

- 3. Manner of Adoption. The foregoing amendment was approved on June 23, 1997 by the required vote of the Shareholders of said Corporation in accordance with Section 607.1003 of the Florida Business Corporation Act; the total number of outstanding shares of each class entitled to vote on the foregoing amendment is 1,000 shares of common stock; and said amendment was approved by the votes of the holders of 1,000 of such shares and by all of the members of the Board of Directors.
- 4. <u>Effective Date</u>. The foregoing amendment shall become effective and the Articles of Incorporation shall be deemed to be amended thereby immediately upon filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
