ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF G.F.D. INCORPORATED

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida Business Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be G.F.D. Incorporated.

ARTICLE II
