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ARTICLES OF INCORPURATION OF TRIPLE J ENTERPRISES, INC.

- (e) To lend money to, and use its credit to assist its officers and employees in accordance with Florida Statute 607.0833.
- (f) To purchase, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge or otherwise dispose of; and deal in and with shares or other interests in, or obligations of, any other entity;
- (g) To make contracts and guarantees, incur liabilities, borrow money, issue its notes, bonds and other obligations (which may be converted into or include the option to purchase other securities of the corporation), and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of any of its property, franchises and income and make contracts of quaranty and suretyship which are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the business of a corporation the majority of the outstanding stock of which is owned, directly or indirectly, by the contracting corporation, a corporation which owns, directly or indirectly, a majority of the outstanding stock of the contracting corporation; or a corporation the majority of the outstanding stock of which is owned, directly or indirectly; by a corporation which owns, directly or indirectly, the majority of the outstanding stock of the contracting corporation, which contracts of guaranty and suretyship shall be deemed to be necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion or attainment of the business of the contracting
