**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
DRACKETT & ASSOCIATES, INC.**

The undersigned incorporator delivers these Articles of Incorporation in order to form a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act.

**ARTICLE I  
Name and Principal Office**

The name of the Corporation shall be DRACKETT & ASSOCIATES, INC. The address of the principal office of the corporation shall be: 1501 E. Amelia Street, Orlando, Florida 32803.

**ARTICLE II  
Corporate Purposes, Power and Rights**

The purpose of the Corporation is to engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and the State of Florida.

**ARTICLE III  
Duration of the Corporation**

Existence of the Corporation shall commence on the date all fees are paid and these Articles of Incorporation are filed by the Secretary of State and the Corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

**ARTICLE IV  
Authorized Stock**

The total number of shares of capital stock which the Corporation has the authority to issue is ten thousand (10,000) shares of Common Stock, with a \$1.00 par value per share. Each holder of common shares shall have one vote for each such share held of record on all matters submitted for shareholder approval. Except as otherwise specifically required by law, or except as specifically provided in these articles of incorporation, all other matters requiring shareholder approval shall require an affirmative vote of a majority of the shares voting thereon. The holders of the common shares shall have unlimited voting rights and the right to receive the net assets of the corporation upon its dissolution.

**ARTICLE V**  
**Registered Office and Registered Agent**

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation in the State of Florida shall be c/o W. EDWARD MCLEOD, P.A., 201 South Orange Avenue, Suite 1010, Orlando, Florida 32801. The name of the initial registered agent of the Corporation at the registered office shall be W. EDWARD MCLEOD, ESQUIRE.

**ARTICLE VI**  
**Initial Board of Directors**

The initial Board of Directors shall consist of two (2) persons. The names and addresses of those persons who shall serve as directors of the Corporation until the first meeting of shareholders are:

**ARTICLE VIII**  
**Indemnity**

The corporation shall indemnify to the fullest extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act any person who has been made, or is threatened to be made, a party to an action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, investigative, or otherwise (including an action, suit or proceeding by or in the right of the corporation), by reason of the fact that the person is or was a director or officer of the corporation, or a fiduciary within the meaning of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 with respect to an employee benefit plan of the corporation, or serves or served at the request of the corporation as a director, or as an

officer, or as a fiduciary of an employee benefit plan, of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise. In addition, the corporation shall pay for or reimburse any expenses incurred by such persons who are parties to such proceedings, in advance of the final disposition of such proceedings, to the full extent permitted by the Florida Business Corporation Act.


#### ARTICLE IX Preemptive Rights

#### ARTICLE X Control-Share Acquisitions


The Florida Control-Share Acquisition sections of the Florida Business Corporation Act (§§ 607.0901 through 607.0903) shall not be applicable to this corporation.
