This letter is in response to the recent dissolution notice.

10 weeks after incorporating on November 22, 1996, my wife was severely injured. The business I'd dreamed of taking to success turned into a nightmare as suddenly I had a severely disabled wife and three young daughters to care for. I still have dreams of making my business successful, but my obligations as a spouse and father have come first.

Besides cooking and cleaning and homework duties, on average, I have had to drive to a doctor's appointment once per week. Overnight away trips, once routine, cause increased turmoil at home, and I have to limit them. Over the years, it became obvious that it was too difficult to endure the stress involved with trying to manage a business and coordinate a spouse's recovery with raising children. I couldn't do it well; there just weren't enough hours in the day.

The coordination of diminished cash flow has been extremely difficult to manage. Three times this year, power has been cut to our home. The economy has caused my customers to experience cash flow problems of their own, and this has affected me, my family and the business.

My eldest daughter, a junior in high school, came home last week with a new varsity letter, for her academic achievements. My efforts are not without reward...

Please give us a break. We're really trying, and I am actively promoting my business, hoping to get better cash flow without too much overwhelm. If you cannot waive the late filing fees, could you accept periodic payments?
