Gentlemen,

Enclosed please find a copy your second request for an annual report for the above referenced corporation as well as a check for \$165.00. Per our telephone conversation we are requesting an abatement of the \$385.00 extra charge as a result of reasonable cause as follows:

- (1) The company is a brand new corporation and applied for a corporate charter in late 1996 to become active as of January 01, 1997. Evidently some oversight existed which caused this active in late 1996.
- (2) Employment Publications, Inc. is a new startup operation in the employment publication business and payment of this additional charge would result in undue financial hardship on this new business.
- (3) The president of this corporation did not understand what this form was about, how to properly fill this out, or why there was a \$165.00 charge. During the period during which he sent it to his accountant it became late. (his accountant is not in the same city and the mailing time accounted for the delay.)
