To Whom It May Concern:

Regarding the enclosed reinstatement application for The Loan Pros, Inc., since the 1997 incorporation date the corporation has changed office locations three times. The owner has indicated that to the best of his knowledge, he has never received any Annual Reports for the corporation.

The taxpayer has indicated to me that there was some difficulty in having the mail sent from location to another due to administrative problems resulting from employee turnover. The taxpayer has filed all federal and state tax returns on time and adhered to all other reporting requirements. The required annual reports were not filed simply because the taxpayer did not receive the forms, and was not aware to look for the form.

The taxpayer has now retained my services as CPA and Registered Agent to assure that all reporting requirements are met, and I do not anticipate that the taxpayer will violate any reporting requirements in the future. On behalf of the taxpayer I am requesting an abatement of late filing penalties due to reasonable cause.

The taxpayer in no way intended not to file or violate any reporting requirement. The taxpayer simply did not receive the form due to several moves and was not aware of its existence to do any follow up. The non-filing situation was accidentally discovered by the taxpayer during a credit check. Again, the taxpayer has now retained a CPA to insure this situation will not occur in the future.

Enclosed is a properly completed reinstatement form with a check for \$450.00. The form contains the new address and the taxpayer is now aware of the reporting requirement and knows to look for the Uniform Business Report in the future.
