The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be FLORIDA FOOD & BEVERAGE COMPANY, INC.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless sooner dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III
