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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

The undersigned subscriber (s) to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation under the Laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE 1. - NAME

The name of this corporation is: Barbara A. Driscoll RN P.A.

ARTICLE II. - NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation shall be:

- (a) To engage in the professional functions of providing nursing, education, consulting and management service, and to engage in any and all functions, services, and/or activities considered necessary, incidental, proper and/or ancillary thereto, and to do all other things which may be desirable to achieve the purposes aforesaid and to operate a successful business.


