ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the Florida General Corporation Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE ONE - Name

The name of the corporation is CRAIG B. STRANIGAN, D.M.D., P.A.

ARTICLE TWO - Duration

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.
