ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF AMERICAN OUTBOARD RACING ASSOCIATION, INC.



ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be AMERICAN OUTBOARD RACING ASSOCIATION, INC..

ARTICLE II. COMMENCEMENT & DURATION

The commencement of this corporation's existence shall be at the time of the filing of these Articles Of Incorporation by the Florida Department of State This corporation's duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This corporation is being organized for the purpose of engaging in the transaction of any and all business activities permitted under the laws of Florida and the United States of America.

ARTICLE IV. CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation shall have the authority to issue 1,500 par value shares of common capital stock.
