ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

AMERICAN FIBERCRETE INTERNATIONAL, INC.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation is - AMERICAN FIBERCRETE INTERNATIONAL, INC.

ARTICLE II - DURATION

This Corporation is to exist perpetually. It shall commence existence on the date of filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized for all lawful purposes in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV - CAPITAL STOCK

This Corporation is authorized to issue * 5,000 * shares of common stock at ONE DOLLAR (\$1.00) par value. Shares may be issued for such consideration as is determined from time to time by the shareholders. This power is reserved unto the shareholders by right and is hereby delegated unto the Board of Directors. The Board may issue the shares of this Corporation for such consideration as is determined from time to time by it, unless and until the shareholders by affirmative action communicate to the Board, in writing, their decision to determine the consideration for the issuance of non-issued or sale of treasury shares. This action by the shareholders will not affect prior action by the Board.

The consideration for the issuance of shares or for the disposal of treasury shares may be paid, in whole or un part, in cash or other property, tangible or intangible, or in labor or services actually performed for the Corporation. Shares may not be issued until the full amount of the consideration therefore has been paid. When payment of the consideration for which shares are to be issued shall have been received by the Corporation such shares shall be deemed to be fully paid and non-assessable.

ARTICLE V - PREEMPTIVE RIGHTS

The shareholders or record of this Corporation shall have preemptive rights, proportional to their ownership, to acquire unissued or treasure shares of the Corporation, or those shares for sale by any retiring shareholders, or securities of the Corporation convertibles into or carrying a right to subscribe to or acquire shares, or any future issue of shares or convertible securities, bonds or debentures agreed to by the Board of Directors or Shareholders Meeting of this Corporation. This right shall be exercised by the said shareholders in a period of sixty days from the resolution taken by the Board of Directors or Shareholders Meeting, or from the notice to sell delivered by the selling shareholder to the Secretary of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI - INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE

ARTICLE VIII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall have FIVE (5) Director(s) initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time in such manner as may be prescribed in the By-Laws, but there shall never be less than one (1) director.

ARTICLE X - INDEMNIFICATION

This Corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless each person who shall serve at any time hereafter as a Director or Officer of the Corporation, and in its name and as it representative in any other corporation, from and against any and all claims and liabilities to which such person shall come subject by reason of his having heretofore or hereafte, been a Director of Officer of the Corporation, or by reason of any action alleged to have been heretofore or hereafter taken or omitted by him as such Director or Officer, and shall reimburse each such person for all legal and other expenses provided that no person shall be indemnified against, or be reimbursed for, any expenses incurred in connection with any claim or liability as to which it shall be adjudged that such Officer or Director is liable for negligence or willful misconduct in the performance of his duties. The right accruing to any person under the foregoing provisions shall not exclude any other right to which he may lawfuly be entitled, nor shall anything herein contained restrict the right of the Corporation to indemnify or reimburse such person in any proper case even though not specifically herein provided.

ARTICLE XI - REMOVAL OF DIRECTORS

Any Director, or the entire Board of Directors may be removed with or without casuse, by a vote of the holders of a maority of the shares then entitled to vote at an election of Directors, at a special meeting of shareholders called expressly for that purpose.
