The name of this Corporation is THE PRACTICE TEE/ORLANDO, INC.

It is the intention of the Corporation to indemnify its officers, directors, employees, and agents to the extent permitted by Section 607.0850, Florida Statutes.

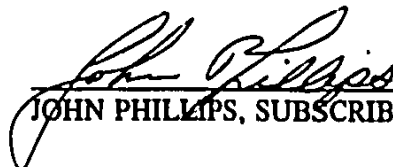
ARTICLE VIII

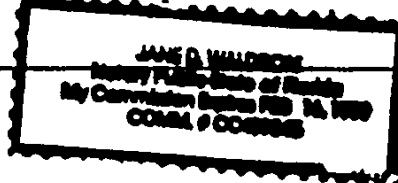
