ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PETE O'CONNOR, INC.

Article I - Name

The name of the corporation is PETE O'CONNOR, INC.

Article II - Duration

This corporation shall exist perpetually commencing on the date of January 1, 1997, or upon the date of filing.

Article III - Purpose
This corporation is organized for the purpose of
transacting any or all lawful business permitted under the
laws of the United States and Florida.

Article IV - Capital Stock
The corporation is authorized to issue one thousand
(1000) shares of one dollar(\$1.00) par value common stock.

Article V - Preferences, Limitations and Relative
Rights Of Shares Of Capital Stock
Voting Rights: Except as otherwise provided by law,
the entire voting power for the election of directors and
for all other purposes shall be vested exclusively in the
holders of the outstanding common shares.

Article VI - Pre-emptive Rights

Every shareholder, upon the sale for cash of any new stock of this corporation of the same kind, class or series as that which he already holds, shall have the right to purchase his pro rata share thereof (as nearly as may do done without issuance of fractional shares) at the price at which it is offered to others.

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Article VII - Initial Registered Office and Agent

The street address of the principal office and of the initial registered office of this corporation is 3927 W 26th Court, Panama City, Florida 32405, and the name of the initial registered agent of this corporation at that address is Peter R Oconnor.

Article VIII - Initial Board of Directors and Officers

This corporation shall have one director initially. The number of directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by the by-laws, but shall never be less than one. The name and address of the initial director of this corporation is as follows:

Article X - By-Laws

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal by-laws shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the shareholders.

Article XI - Restrictions on Transfer of Stock Shares of capital stock shall be issued initially to the following persons: Peter R Oconnor, 50%, and Sharon K Oconnor, 50%. Shares held by the initial shareholders listed above may not be resold or otherwise transferred to other persons unless such shares are first offered to the remaining shareholders or to this corporation. The price and terms at which, and the time within which, such shares may be offered and sold shall be further specified by written agreement among all of the shareholders and this corporation.

Article XII - Cumulative Voting
At each such election for directors every shareholder
entitled to vote at such election shall have the right to
cumulate his votes by giving one candidate as many votes as
the number directors to be elected at that time multiplied
by the number of shares, or by distributing such votes on
the same principle among any number of such candidates.

Article XIII - Calling Of Special Meetings Special meeting of shareholders may be called by a majority of the outstanding shares.

Article XIV - Shareholder Quorum and Voting Fifty-one percent (51%) of the shares entitled to vote, represented in person or by proxy, shall constitute a quorum at a meeting of shareholders. If a quorum is present, the affirmative vote, fifty-one percent (51%) of the shares represented at the meeting and entitled to vote on the

subject matter, shall be the act of the shareholders.

Article XV - Shareholders Meeting Required

The shareholders of this corporation may take action by written consent as provided by law.

Article XVI - Management of Corporation by Directors

All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business affairs of this corporation shall be managed under the direction of, the directors of this corporation.

Article XVII - Director Quorum and Voting

A majority of the directors shall constitute a quorum

for a meeting of directors. If a quorum is present, the

affirmative vote of a majority of the directors present, or,

if a director or directors have abstained from voting in the

matter to be voted upon, the affirmative vote of a majority

of the remaining directors shall be the act of the Board of

Directors.

Article XVIII - Meeting by Conference Telephone

Members of the Board of Directors may participate in
meetings of the Board of Directors by means of conference
telephone as provided by law.

Article XIX - Action by Directors Without a Meeting

The Directors of this corporation may take action

bywritten consent as provided by law.

Article XX - Indemnification

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director any former officer or director to the full extent

or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

Article XXI - Amendment
This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal
any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation,
