ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

The undersigned subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation, each a natural person, competent to contract, hereby associate themselves together to form a corporation for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be MIDLAN DEVELOPMENT CORP., INC.

ARTICLE II

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted and which corporation is authorized to transact, in addition to those authorized by the Laws of the State of Florida, and the powers of said corporation, in addition to the powers granted by the State of Florida, shall be as follows:

Section 1: To develop real estate into motel, hotel and Hostel type public accommodations, including indoor Flea Markets and all other commercial properties. Further, to establish a Foundation with the objective of helping introduce women into the business world and assist in their advancement therein.
