government or subdivisions, agencies or instrumentalities thereof, to make payment therefore in any lawful manner or to issue in exchange therefore its own securities or to use its unrestricted or unreserved earned surplus for the purchase of its own shares, and to exercise as owner or holder of any securities, any and all rights, powers and privileges in respect thereof.

A. To do each and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purpose or the attainment of any one or more of the subjects herein enumerated, or which may at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the protection or benefit of this corporation, and to do said acts as fully and to the same extent as natural persons reight, or could do, in any part of the world as principals, agents, partners, trustees or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with any other person, association or corporation.

B. The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as purposes and powers, and shall not be held to limit of restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation, and the enjoyment and exercise thereof, as conferred by the laws of the State of Florida; and it is the intention that the purposes and powers specified in each of the paragraphs of this Article III shall be regarded as independent powers.

ARTICLE V - AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended, altered, changed or repealed by the affirmative vote of a majority of the stock issued and outstanding at a shareholder's meeting called for that purpose.

ARTICLE VI - SHAREHOLDER RIGHTS

Shareholders of the corporation shall have pre-emptive rights to acquire their prorata share of stock of the corporation for all issues of any class of stock of the
corporation, no matter when authorized, and for whatever consideration is contemplated
to be received by the corporation, including, but not limited to, cash, other property,
services, the acquisition of other corporations' shares, or property through merger or
extinguishment of debts. Pre-emptive rights shall also apply to the reissuance of all
redeemed or otherwise acquired shares, including the reissuance of treasury shares.

This Article pertaining to pre-emptive rights may not be amended or deleted without the unanimous vote of the shareholders of each affected class, and no issuance of the stock of the corporation shall take place unless the price at which the stock is to be issued shall be approved by a majority of the shareholders of the corporation.
