

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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
TECNI-CENTER OF AMERICA, INC.

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, hereby forms a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the corporation is Tecni-Center of America, Inc.

ARTICLE II. DURATION AND PURPOSE

The period of the corporation's duration shall be perpetual until dissolved on a vote of the shareholders as hereinafter provided.
