ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a professional corporation under the Florida Professional Service Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME AND PLACE OF BUSINESS

NAME AND PLACE OF BUSINESS: The name of this corporation is:

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This corporation shall exist perpetually. Bylaws shall thereafter be adopted, altered, amended or repealed from time to time by either the shareholders or the directors, but the directors shall not alter, amend or repeal any bylaw adopted by the shareholders if the shareholders specifically provide that such bylaw is not subject to amendment or repeal by the directors.
