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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

I, the undersigned, subscribed to this Certificate of Incorporation, a natural person competent to contract, do hereby form a professional association for profit under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I

ARTICLE II DURATION

The term of existence of the professional association is perpetual.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

- To purchase, take, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein, wherever situated.
- g. To lend money and use its credit to assist its officers and employees in accordance with Section 607.141, Plorida Statutes.
- h. To sell, convey, mortgage, pledge, create a security interest in, lease, exchange, transfer, and otherwise dispose of all or any part of its property and assets.
- To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, mortgage, lend, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, shares or other interests in, or obligations of the United States or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district, or municipality or any instrumentality thereof.
- j. To make contracts and guarantees and incur liabilities, borrow money at such rates of interest as the corporation may determine, issue its notes, bonds, and other obligations, and secure any of its obligations by mortgage or pledge of all or any of its property, franchises, and income.
- k. To lend money for its corporate purposes, invest and reinvest its funds, and take and hold real and personal property as security for the payment of funds so loaned or invested.
- To conduct its business, carry on its operations, and have offices and exercise the powers granted by this Act within or without the state.
- To elect or appoint officers and agents of the professional association and to define their duties and fix their compensation.
- To make and alter bylaws, not inconsistent with its Articles of Incorporation or with the laws of this state, for the administration and regulation of the affairs of the professional association.
- To make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific or educational purposes.
- To transact any lawful business which the Board of Directors shall find will be in aid of governmental policy.

- r. To be a promoter, incorporator, partner, member, associate, or manager of any corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise.
- s. To have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to affect its purposes.
- t. To engage in any activity or business permitted under the laws of the United States and of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV CAPITAL STOCK

The maximum number of shares of stock this professional association is authorised to have outstanding at any one time is 1,000 shares of common stock, each share having the par value of \$1.00. Each stockholder of the professional association shall be entitled to one vote for each fully paid, non-assessable share owned by him, and there shall be no cumulative voting.

ARTICLE V INITIAL CAPITAL

The amount of capital with which the professional association shall begin business shall be not less than Five Hundred Dollars (6500.00).
